

Tax Apportionment Report, November 2024

The collection is based off of September transactions that were reported to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in October and apportioned to the City in November.

2% GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,745,961

- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$29,525 (1.66%)

- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$7,415 (1.61%)

VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$207,825

- NOVEMBER 2023 VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$164,679
- INCREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$43,146 (26.20%)
