*The collection is based off of October transactions that were reported to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in November and apportioned to the City in December.*

### **2% GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,737,129**

- December 2022 GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,742,053
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$-4,924 (-0.28%)

### **1% TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$868,565**

- December 2022 TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$871,026
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$-2,461 (-0.28%)

### **1% STILLWATER UTILITIES AUTHORITY (SUA) SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$868,565**

- December 2022 SUA SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$871,026
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$-2,461 (-0.28%)

### **USE TAX COLLECTION: \$474,715**

- December 2022 USE TAX COLLECTION: \$457,474
- INCREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$17,241 (3.77%)

### **VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$183,887**

- December 2022 VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$198,504
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$-14,617 (-7.36%)
