

Tax Apportionment Report, November 2023

The collection is based off of September transactions that were reported to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in October and apportioned to the City in November.

2% GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,775,486

- November 2022 GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,815,759
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$-40,273 (-2.22%)

1% TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$887,743

USE TAX COLLECTION: \$459,288

- November 2022 USE TAX COLLECTION: \$357,758
- INCREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$101,530 (28.38%)

VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$164,679

- November 2022 VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$187,512
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$-22,833 (-12.18%)
