

Tax Apportionment Report, October 2023

The collection is based off of August transactions that were reported to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in September and apportioned to the City in October.

2% GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$2,012,713

USE TAX COLLECTION: \$497,268

- SEPTEMBER 2022 USE TAX COLLECTION: \$478,865
- INCREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$18,403 (3.84%)

VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$128,529

- SEPTEMBER 2022 VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$121,879
- INCREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$6,650 (5.46%)
