

## Tax Apportionment Report, September 2023

*The collection is based off of July transactions that were reported to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in August and apportioned to the City in September.*

### **2% GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,560,621**

- SEPTEMBER 2022 GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,605,896
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: -\$45,275 (-2.82%)

### **1% TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$780,310**

- SEPTEMBER 2022 TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$802,948
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: -\$22,638 (-2.82%)

### **1% STILLWATER UTILITIES AUTHORITY (SUA) SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$780,310**

- SEPTEMBER 2022 SUA SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$802,948
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: -\$22,638 (-2.82%)

### **USE TAX COLLECTION: \$388,745**

- SEPTEMBER 2022 USE TAX COLLECTION: \$427,633
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: -\$38,888 (-9.09%)

### **VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$104,270**

- SEPTEMBER 2022 VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$123,489
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: -\$19,219 (-15.56%)
