



## Tax Apportionment Report, April 2025

*The collection is based off of February transactions that were reported to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in March and apportioned to the City in April.*

### **2% GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,599,929**

- APRIL 2024 GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,645,845
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$45,916 (-2.79%)

### **1% TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$799,964**

- APRIL 2024 TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$822,922
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$22,958 (-2.79%)

### **1% STILLWATER UTILITIES AUTHORITY (SUA) SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$799,964**

- APRIL 2024 SUA SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$822,922
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$22,958 (-2.79%)

### **USE TAX COLLECTION: \$413,260**

- APRIL 2024 USE TAX COLLECTION: \$411,575
- INCREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$1,685 (0.41%)

### **VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$140,607**

- APRIL 2024 VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$92,801
- INCREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$47,806 (51.51%)
