



Tax Apportionment Report, February 2025

The collection is based off of December transactions that were reported to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in January and apportioned to the City in February.

2% GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,605,264

- FEBRUARY 2024 GENERAL SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$1,650,720
- DECREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$45,456 (-2.75%)

1% TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX COLLECTION: \$802,632

- FEBRUARY 2024 USE TAX COLLECTION: \$493,899
- INCREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$91,221 (18.47%)

VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$136,250

- FEBRUARY 2024 VISITOR TAX COLLECTION: \$98,480
- INCREASE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR: \$37,770 (38.35%)
