



Park Rules



- Parks are open from 5 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- No overnight stays or camping allowed.
- It is illegal to consume or sell alcohol in parks.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- Motorized vehicles must stay on paved parking areas and may not park on grass, except in designated parking areas.
- No swimming is allowed in city lakes.
- Fires must be contained in grills; open fires are not permitted.
- Shelters may be reserved three business days prior to an event. If a reserved sign is not posted, shelters are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Acts of vandalism will be prosecuted.
- No feeding of waterfowl or wildlife is permitted.
- Vendors must have an Itinerant Merchant License, purchased through the City Clerk, and permission from the Community Resources Director to sell food or refreshments in parks.
- Hunting and trapping are not permitted.
