

The City of Stillwater is responsible for keeping city streets clean of trash and debris. The Street Sweeping Program keeps streets cleaner and safer, reduces health hazards related to dust, and ensures trash does not become a refuge for insects and rodents. Regular sweeping also reduces the amount of sedimentation discharged to streams, lakes, ponds and other waterways.

Sweepers operate Monday through Friday, 6 a.m.-2:30 p.m. year-round. Streets are swept on a rotating schedule, with an emphasis on collecting leaves from September to March. Streets with curbs are swept first, then those without curbs, as necessary.
